THE PROBLEM

- Over \$125 million a year spent combating local litter & illegal dumping
- Local monthly trash fees are skyrocketing
- Businesses have a major manufacturing needs for material
- Anti-business federal mandates threaten state & local control
- Texas ranks 42nd in recycling nationwide—behind Iowa & Florida

A PRO-BUSINESS, PRO-TAXPAYER SOLUTION

1 **Reduce litter** & illegal dumping—lowering cleanup costs for taxpayers.

2 **Grow the Texas economy**, increase recycling, & reduce the need for landfill expansion.

THE SOLUTION:

TEXAS PLASTIC RECYCLING COMMODITY BOARD

A 501c3 nonprofit organization for producers of plastic food and beverage containers in Texas. Comptroller will work with recycling stakeholders to approve a plan with three main objectives:

1. Build recycling collection infrastructure across the state
2. Provide education and a financial incentive for consumers to return plastic
3. Reach recycling rate targets, "close the loop" on plastics, and support the circular economy right here in Texas
